OUR LEGACY: a tribute to GEORGE FOX and WILLIAM EDMUNDSON

Recently we received correspondence from Ellen Johnson. While cleaning out her mother's attic, she came across a play written by her step-great grandmother, Josephine Rhodes Davis. The play was first performed in 1929 and commemorated the first recorded religious service in North Carolina.

As 2022 is the 350th anniversary of this significant occasion, Mrs. Johnson permitted us to reprint portions of the play in the Lamplighter over the coming months. We wanted everyone to have a chance to read the work of Josephine Rhodes Davis. This work reveals the early Quaker desire to bring Christianity to the Colonies. The original signed manuscript, donated by Mrs. Johnson, has been placed in the Up River library for preservation. Now we hope you will enjoy the fourth installment of *OUR LEGACY: a tribute to GEORGE FOX and WILLIAM EDMUNDSON*. 🏮

Episode III

Carrying the Religion of Christ into Carolina

FIRST PART: THE "HAMMER OF IRELAND" ARRIVES

TIME: May, 1672

PLACE: House of Henry Phillips, on the Albemarle
(where Hertford now stands)

PERSONS: Henry Phillips and wife, Quaker settlers
William Edmundson, leader of Friends in Ireland

(Henry Phillips is seen peering across the water; his
wife is seen at her work.)

HENRY PHILLIPS: There is a stranger on the other side of the water. Whatever the matter is, I do not know. I shall send a boat and a couple of men to him. (Takes his coat and hat and goes out.)

WIFE (as she too, peers out): A stranger? A stranger? Who can it be?
(She returns to her work; a knock is heard; she goes to

the door, opens it; a man stands there.)
Art thou the stranger my husband has sent for?

WM. EDMUNDSON: I am a stranger.

WIFE: Come in.
(She places a chair, then exits to re-enter with her husband.)

HENRY PHILLIPS: Art thou the stranger that I have sent for?

WM. EDMUNDSON: Whom thou may'st expect I do not know but I am a stranger.

HENRY PHILLIPS: What a mercy is this, that the Lord should send a friend from I know not where in His love to visit us.

WM. EDMUNDSON: My home is in Ireland, but it is long since I was there.

HENRY PHILLIPS: I believe I know who thou art, and thy business too. Thou art William Edmundson, the gifted preacher. News travels slowly in this wilderness country, but we heard that thou art come; come to help us and strengthen us. Is George Fox with thee?

WM. EDMUNDSON: George Fox was with me until after the General Meeting in Maryland. He then went by boat to the eastern shore; other Friends went to New England.

HENRY PHILLIPS: We settled here from New England seven years since; persecutions there are intolerable.

WM. EDMUNDSON: Aye, we have come a long way to visit Friends and encourage them. I desire thee to send to the people here-away for a meeting at about noon today; another meeting tomorrow; the following day I must depart. Thy name?

HENRY PHILLIPS: Henry Phillips. This, my wife.

WIFE: Friends will be glad to see thee. Thou art weary and faint and thy clothes are wet. I will prepare food for thee and a place for thee to rest. (Exit wife.)

HENRY PHILLIPS (*taking the hand of William Edmundson*): The Lord in His great love hath remembered us.

CURTAIN

Episode III

SECOND PART: EDMUNDSON PLEADS WITH
THEE AND ME

TIME: Noon of the same day

PLACE: House of Henry Phillips

PERSONS: William Edmundson Henry Phillips
and wife Francis Toms, justice of the peace,
Albemarle And others

*(Enter William Edmundson, Henry Phillips and wife.
They take seats as in a Friends Meeting.)*

HENRY PHILLIPS: It is the desire of our Friend, William Edmundson, to say that this meeting is appointed for the defense of God and His Kingdom, and not for the asking of questions, or for controversies, or for contentions: I apprehend that liberty will be given for such in the conclusion. And now may the Lord give us the spirit of discerning.

(Silence)

WM. EDMUNDSON: Something more than a year ago, dear friends, George Fox and twelve others, including myself and two women, felt a holy concern to visit Friends in person throughout this nation: to begin and establish the True Gospel amongst them.

On the twelfth of last sixth month, we took leave of England in great tenderness, to voyage across the sea. On our way here we visited Friends in Barbadoes and the Island of Jamaica, settling meetings there and despatching the service for which the Lord sent us thither. From Jamaica we came to Maryland: there we separated to our respective labors in the work of the Gospel. James Lancaster and John Cartwright went to New England; George Fox and others went to the eastern shore; I and three Friends more sailed for Virginia. From there we hastened to Carolina.

I dare not speak of the dangers we encountered: dangers we durst not have undertaken if we had not believed it required of us by the Almighty and

our peace concerned in it, and the good of the children of men. These are the motives of our great undertakings. I am come, dear friends, under no small concern of mind, and I desire that you receive the Truth with openness, that our meeting though small may be precious. It is opened to me so clearly: *hold fast the profession of your faith without wavering.*

The Lord, dear friends, doth require more of you than he doth of other people, because he hath committed more to you. The world also expects more from Friends than from other people, because you profess more.

You profess, dear friends, that Truth which is beyond the world's ways: pray see that you excel the world in virtue, in kindness, in love that is over hatred, in temperance, in all morality. So to excel is in keeping with Christ's injunction. Show forth true Christianity: that you dwell in the love that endureth all things and envies not. Stir up the gift of God in you, and the pure mind, and improve your talents, that you may be the light of the world, a city set upon a hill that cannot be hid. Let your light shine among the Indians and the Negroes, that you may answer the Truth in them to the standard of Jesus Christ. And now that you are come into so much favor with the magistrates and powers that they let you serve without taking oaths, I desire that you double your diligence in your offices in doing that which is just, true and righteous, according to Christ's commands.

Dear friends, you should write once a year to your mother Yearly Meeting in New England, concerning your diligence in the Truth, and of its spreading, and of people's receiving it; and concerning your peace amongst yourselves. Never forsake, dear friends, the assembling of yourselves together: but do you keep close to meetings, for all the members of Christ have need one of another; let none despise the least member. Visit often, correspond often, communicate with kind hearts to one another, remembering that you desend of one most tender Father.

And now, dear friends, it is upon me from the Lord, that He doth much manifest His love and power in these parts. Therefore, fear not, little flock, for Christ is in your midst, a Free Teacher, who saith, "Learn of Me," "the Way, the Truth, and

the Life.”

May you grow in His Spirit and in the favor of God and of men. My life and love is to you.

FRANCIS TOMS (from the rear of the meeting): I desire to have the liberty to speak.... I have received the Truth with gladness, and desire that the meeting tomorrow be held at my house, three miles off, on the other side of the water.

HENRY PHILLIPS: Are Friends willing?

FRIENDS: I’m willing. It suits me. I’m satisfied.

(The meeting concludes in the customary manner.)

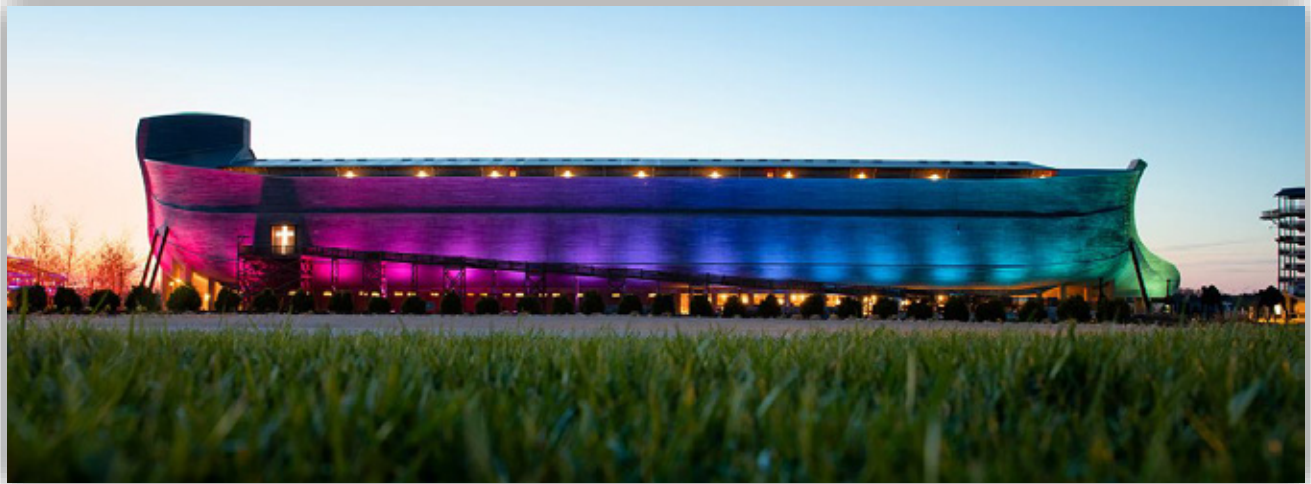

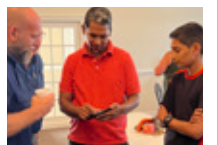
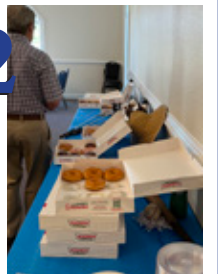

What Makes A Godly Father?

The work of parenting is so vital. Fathers especially are essential to the family unit. As men, we sometimes do not want to admit that we do not have all the answers. Often, we do not desire to reach out for help from others. We want to appear strong, even if we are breaking on the inside. The truth is, every father benefits when he places himself under the watchful care of the heavenly Father. Having God as our helper and guide requires our being godly. Dads, how do we achieve this? I'm glad you asked. Let us consider what makes a godly father.

First, a godly father is a child of The Father. We can become adopted children of God when we first place our faith and trust in Christ Jesus (Ephesians 1:5). Romans 10:9 explains that when we confess Jesus and believe in our hearts that God raised Him from the dead, we can enter into an adopted-son relationship with God. When we are in this relationship with God through Christ Jesus, we have access to God's unlimited knowledge and wisdom. When we struggle, we can turn to our Abba Father and glean from His eternal wisdom (Proverbs 2:1-4). Remember, the only way to enter this relationship with God is through Jesus, His only begotten Son (John 14:6).

Second, a godly father lives honestly before his family. As men, we will mess up. We will say the wrong thing, lose our temper, bring our work stress home, and behave in less than a godly fashion in front of our family. When you mess up, own your mistake. Tell your family: "Don't blame Jesus for how I acted."

Your honesty will cause your family to trust you. Dr. Erik Erikson believed that children are not born trusting; thus, trust is learned. When your children and family see you living out your faith, even in the 'less than ideal times,' they will know they can trust you as you follow Christ.

Finally, a godly father depends solely upon The Father. Dads, there may be times you feel that your faith is diminished. You might think that your heavenly Father is not around. If you are truly living for Him, I want you to understand that God is holding on to you in these times. Psalm 46:1 states that God is a very present help. How often have



you carried your sleeping child in from the car and placed them in a warm, safe bed? The next day, your child might think, "Look what I did last night." Is it not the same with us? How often have we thought, "I have gone from point A to point B, and where is God?" In

reality, God has been holding on to us and directing our paths in the background. Yes, a godly father depends solely upon The Father; even when we are not sure He is there, we believe through faith that He is holding on to us in these times.

Dad, I do not know where you are in your walk with Christ. Remember, if you are sincere in your relationship with The Father, He has made the way for you to be His child, live honestly before your family, and depend solely upon Him. I encourage you to be the godly father our heavenly Father desires. 🏡

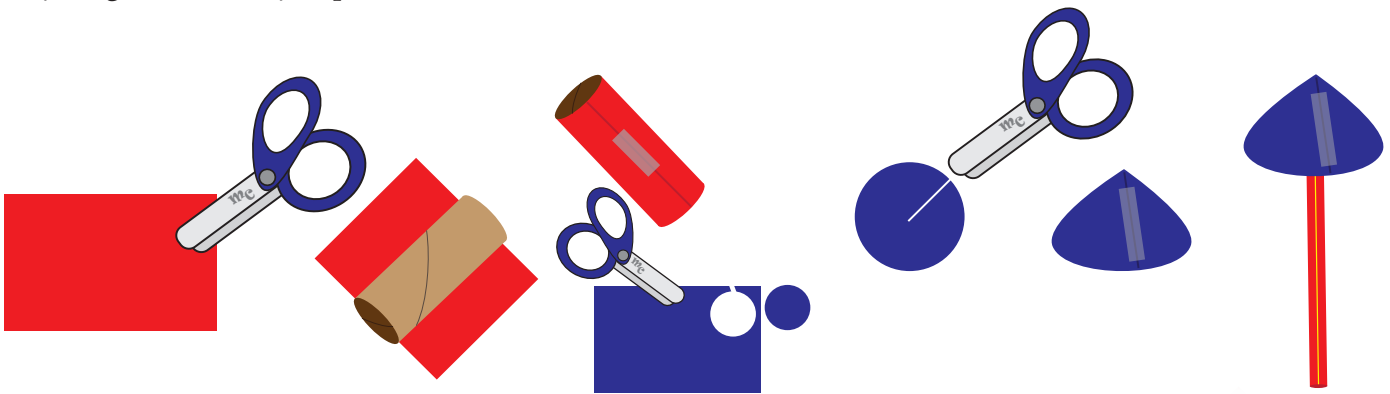


Crafting for Young Friends

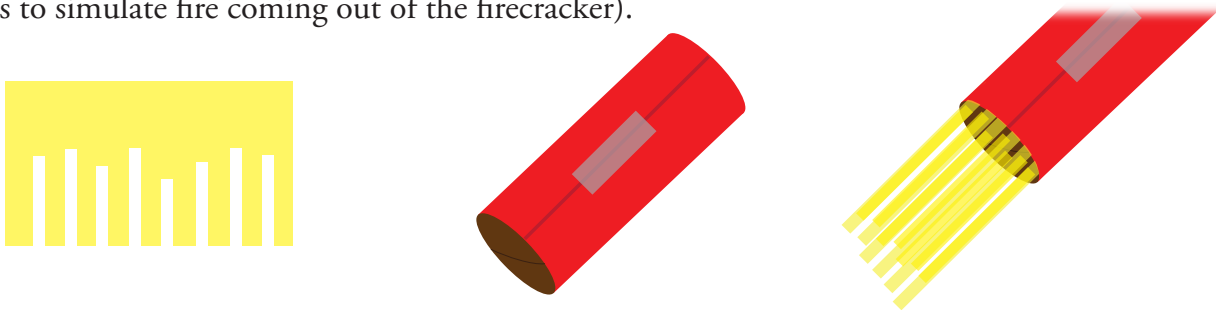
Firecracker Decoration

You Will Need: Scissors, tape, toilet tissue tube, straw, construction paper, tissue paper, rubber/paper cement (or glue).

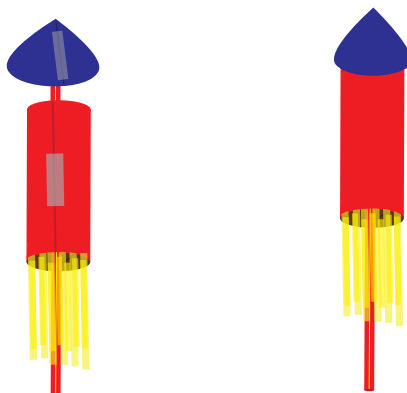
1) Start cutting construction paper with scissors to fit and wrap around the toilet tissue tube. **REMEMBER!** *Any time a child uses scissors, there must be an adult present.* Next, cut, with scissors, a circle out of construction paper. The circle should be just a little larger than the round end of the toilet tissue tube. Then, cut a line to about the middle of the circle and make a cone shape. Tape the two ends, so the cone stays together. Finally, tape the straw inside the cone.



2) Then fringe, with scissors, a small piece of tissue paper and tape the fringed paper to one end of the tube (this is to simulate fire coming out of the firecracker).



3) Finally, take the straw with the cone attached and put the straw through the toilet tissue tube. Take a little rubber/paper cement and glue the cone to the other end of the toilet tissue tube.
