

for preschoolers, church members or anyone that has a choking event. It will be kept in the AED machine case.

We plan to host fall school pictures this month for our preschoolers. Jessica Winslow Chappell will return as our photographer. We can't wait to share our pictures with our church family!

Last, but most importantly, we have a child that is severely allergic to peanuts, so we will be implementing a peanut free campus during preschool hours. Please be mindful when serving snacks in classrooms at all times and make sure not to leave snacks containing peanuts behind.

I'd again like to express our appreciation of everyone's love and support, from supplies, to funding, to time, to prayers, to pumpkins and everything in between!

# Meet Marianne Coetzee: Africa Missions

The ministry of Missionary Marianne Coetzee thoroughly blessed our hearts on September 18, 2022. We had a small taste of heaven when we combined Marianne's ministry with music by Missionary Rose Boyd.

Marianne is serving in the Pentecostal Holiness Church, Western Cape Conference,

South Africa. She serves on the Conference Board as Treasurer and Co-Ordinator for the Bible College and training. She is based in Cape Town.

Her passion is to train and develop South African Christians in order to fulfil the Great Commission. She constantly develops curriculum and training material for leadership in South Africa. She assists in training in Clergy Development.

She loves to work with young people and does Christian Life Coaching in both primary as well as high Schools, working in squatter camps and informal settlements.

Marianne was appointed on the 1st January 2004 as Principal / Director of Cape Bible Training Centre in Cape Town, South Africa. She served in this position until July 2014. She is a South African National, who voluntary taught at Cape Bible Training Centre since 1989, dedicating herself to teaching, before her appointment as Principal.

Marianne served as a Reserve Force Chaplain in the Naval Division of the South African Defence Force from 2006 until 2015. She served in several Units in Simon's Town and was involved in Curriculum development and projects. She also served in Saldanha Naval Training Base as a Chaplain with the National Youth Service.

Missions is very close to Marianne's heart and she has been involved as a tentmaker missionary, cross culturally in South Africa since 1973. She was a co pioneer and church planter of a Pentecostal Holiness Church Lotus River, Cape Town. She has also been on several mission outreaches to Zimbabwe, Zambia, Malawi, Kenya, Lesotho, Botswana and other countries.

She has served on the Pentecostal Holiness Church Western Cape Conference as a Conference Board Member and C.E.M. Director as well as Director of Equipping the Saints. She has a heart for youth and children and has been involved in Children's ministry, clown ministry and drama for many years.

Her main ministry is training and teaching and her desire is to see African's trained in ministry, so that they can train and reach others for Christ.

New Beginnings Life Coaching enables her to reach out to women with training, in order for them to be empowered in every area of their lives.

Her heart is to develop individuals to become a holistically healthy community, who promotes peace and stability, and leads quality Christian lives with the necessary skills they have acquired through training.

Up River gave her \$500.00, but as a church, we received \$2000.00; thus, we could give her

a check for \$2500.00 dollars. Our giving will help her continue her mission

work and aid the school children in Masiphumelele on the Cape Peninsula of South Africa. Thank you for your faithfulness.

You Will Need: You Will Need: marker, construction paper, glue, buttons.


1) Start by drawing random lines on the construction paper with a marker.








2) Take time gluing buttons to the end of the lines.
