God's Unfailing Love

The psalmist records to let the morning bring word of God's unfailing love because we have put our trust in God. Show us the way we should go, for to God we entrust our life (Psalm 143:8). The psalmist paints a beautiful portrait of God's love for humanity.

The psalmist begins by saying, let the morning bring word of God's unfailing love. The truth about the born-again child of God: no matter how badly you have messed up in the past, God's love and mercies are new every morning. For the Christian, who goes to bed and wakes up, it is like God's love is new and fresh every day. For God, it's merely a continuation of His constant, unchanging character.

This psalmist goes on and stresses, let the morning bring word of God's unfailing love because we have put our trust in Him. This statement is vital to understand God's love properly. I am convinced that God loves all humanity, but to experience His love you must put your trust in Christ. I believe He loves the people who never trust Him, but they can never know the boundlessness of His great love in the way that Christians know His love.

Show us the way we should go the psalmist records next. God will never lead the believer down the wrong path. When we diligently seek God's direction, He will guide us (Psalm 23:3). Guidance is a very loving act on the part of God. For the bornagain believer, God has given His Spirit to live inside you and guide you (Romans 8:14). We are not lost in this life if we choose God; quite the opposite, we are empowered, nurtured, and loved.

The psalmist closes by stating, 'for to God we entrust our life.' Again, the condition of placing trust in God is reiterated and amplified. The psalmist first says he will trust God; now, he states that he will entrust his life to God. This final action gives everything to God. For the New Testament believer, we give ourselves to God by believing in Jesus' atoning work at Calvary. Jesus did for us what we could not do for ourselves. When we give ourselves completely and wholly to Him, we can experience His love in ways we never thought or dreamed (Ephesians 3:20).

If you have never given your life to Jesus, I encourage you to do so today. When you do, like the psalmist, you will say: I have entrusted my life to Christ Jesus.

On February 6, 2023, a 7.8 earthquake struck southern and central Türkiye and northern and western Syria. The mainshock was the strongest earthquake in Türkiye since 1939 (of the same magnitude). The earthquake had a maximum Mercalli intensity of XI (Extreme), followed by a 7.7 earthquake nine hours later. There was widespread damage and tens of thousands of fatalities.

We thank everyone who donated to help with the relief efforts in Türkiye and Syria. Up River sent roughly 136 lbs. of blankets, sleeping bags, Winter clothing, and a few miscellaneous bedding and clothing items.

We need volunteers to help deliver meals for Meals On Wheels. If you are interested in this avenue of personal ministry, contact **Jackie Twombly:** (252) 619-3533. Meals are picked up at the church Monday through Friday, and the delivery should take no longer than one hour to complete.

Preschool News




