

THE OPEN DOOR FOOD LION CASH CARD PROGRAM

We hope you will consider being a part of **The Open Door Food Lion Cash Card Program**. This program is a significant fundraiser for The Open Door of Perquimans County – Your Local Food Pantry.

HOW IT WORKS.

You purchase a cash card for any even dollar denomination from \$5 to \$500 per card. These cards do not expire, nor do they carry any fees. Food Lion gift cards may be redeemed at any Food Lion store. You may use your card to purchase any item except money orders, lottery tickets, other gift cards or pay for returned checks and pay utility bills.

A discount of 5% of the total order is given to The Open Door from Food Lion. Your gift card is for the entire dollar amount of your contribution. Bulk Food Lion cards for customers, employees, family, etc. are available. You may choose to receive more than one card per order, with varied amounts. They make great gifts!

The orders are made monthly, and you will be reminded, by email, of the date the order is to be due at HUMC. Usually within a week, we receive the cards for distribution to those who purchased them.

EVERYONE WINS!

This is convenient for you, business for Food Lion, and hundreds of dollars for our Open Door of Perquimans County.

If you record the number on your card and your gift card is lost or stolen, Food Lion can determine that it has not been redeemed and has some remaining value. After that, you can cancel your original card and a new card will be reissued for that value.






Crafting for Young Friends Turkey Windsock

You Will Need: You Will Need: toilet tissue tube, feathers, ribbon, scissors, tape, glue, construction paper, google eyes.


1) Start by creating a face for your turkey. Cut, with scissors, a triangle shape for a beak, and glue the triangle, along with google eyes and feathers, to the toilet tissue tube until the turkey face looks desirable.



2) With scissors, cut the ribbon and tape it to the bottom of the tube. The ribbon will act as streamers for the windsock.



3) Finally, attach ribbon to the top of the windsock. This ribbon will act as a hanger. Now hang the windsock and watch it move in the wind.
